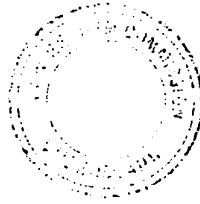

As the Commission mentioned in its last Annual Report, one of the responsibilities with which it is charged by section 10 of the Law Reform Commission Act 1968 is the repealing of obsolete and unnecessary enactments and the reduction in the number of separate enactments with the object of achieving the simplification and modernisation of the law.

Existing Queensland statute law is derived from three sources:-

- (a) Imperial Acts;
- (b) Acts passed by the Legislature of New South Wales prior to 1859; and
- (c) Acts passed by the Queensland Legislature since 1859.

The Law Reform Commission has made its Report to you concerning the Acts in the second of these categories and they appear in the Schedule to the Bill entitled the New South Wales Acts (Termination of Application) Act 1973.

As an item in its next Programme of statute law revision submitted to you for approval, the Commission included an examination of the Imperial statutes with a view to the repeal of those which cannot be shown to continue to perform a useful or necessary function. A review of the statutes in the third of the above categories forms the subject of this Report.

The Commission's investigations have revealed that between 1860 and 1971, 3823 Acts were passed by the Queensland Legislature. Since 1860, 1741 of these have been repealed, become exhausted, or been superseded. Of the remainder 1137 were obviously still effective but there were another 945 which the Commission felt comprised some which may still be required and others which might well be repealed. To determine into which category the lastnamed Acts should be divided enquiries were forwarded to various Government Departments, Local Authorities, the Law Society, the Bar Association and other bodies affected by the legislation concerned to ascertain their attitude in relation thereto.

To date not all enquiries have been answered so in consequence there remain a number of Acts in respect of which no final decision has been made. From the replies already received and its own deliberations, the Commission has compiled a list of 303 Acts, appearing in the Appendix to this Report, all of which, in the opinion of the Commission, can be repealed forthwith. The remainder will be the subject of a further Report when the outstanding replies are to hand.

In our opinion the Acts in the Appendix may be considered in need of repeal because either:-

- (a) the purpose for which an Act was passed no longer exists or has been fulfilled; or
- (b) its operation has been exhausted; or
- (c) it has been superseded by a Commonwealth Act.


"The Ipswich School of Arts Act of 1863" is an example of the first of the above categories. This Act gave trustees the power to mortgage which they utilised, but the land no longer belongs to the trustees. There are also numerous Government Loan Acts which enabled stock to be issued to raise funds for public purposes. As the stock has been redeemed the legislation is no longer required. Again, there are various Mining Leases Acts and Railways Acts where the lease or railway line no longer exists. Likewise, with the conclusion of the particular financial year, the numerous Appropriation Acts passed from year to year have become exhausted.


There are also a number of Acts relating to matters within the legislative competence of the Commonwealth where the Commonwealth passed legislation which has superseded the existing State law. If the Commonwealth legislation were subsequently repealed Queensland law on the subject would again operate and many of them are now completely outmoded and anachronistic. It is accordingly suggested that they now be repealed and if the Commonwealth were to hand back the particular field of legislation to the State, up-to-date legislation could be enacted by the Queensland Parliament.

Among the Acts retained are those which amended earlier legislation - in some instances by as little as a word, a phrase or a section. It was considered that the re-enacting of statutes merely for the purpose of consolidation to include such amendments would not in most circumstances be justified at this stage. Such matters will be dealt with in a separate Report at a later date.


Most of the Acts appearing in the Schedule have already been widely circulated amongst interested bodies, particularly the Government Departments concerned, and therefore, as in its earlier Report on Statute Law Revision, the Commission has not issued the usual Working Paper.

BRISBANE.

A Bill to Repeal certain Acts passed by the Legislature of Queensland.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Acts Repeal Act 1973.
2. Repeals. The Acts set out in the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed.
3. Savings. The repeal by this Act of the Acts set out in the Schedule does not -
 - (a) revive anything not in force or existing at the commencement of this Act;
 - (b) affect the previous operation of, or anything duly done or suffered under, any Act so repealed;
 - (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability accrued, acquired or incurred under any Act so repealed;
 - (d) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any Act so repealed; or
 - (e) affect any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed and enforced as if this Act had not been passed.
4. Revival of repealed enactments. (1) The Governor in Council may by Proclamation declare that any provision (in this section called "the revived provision") being the whole or any part of any Act repealed by this Act shall be revived as from the date of publication of the Proclamation or a later date to be specified in the Proclamation.
 - (2) On and after the date of revival the revived provision shall, subject to Acts from time to time in force, have such effect as the revived enactment had immediately before the commencement of this Act.
 - (3) The revival under this section of any revived provision shall not -
 - (a) affect the previous operation of any repeal effected by section 2 of this Act;
 - (b) affect anything duly done or suffered before the date of revival;

- (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability accrued, acquired or incurred before the date of revival, or any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation or liability; or
- (d) make any person liable for any penalty, forfeiture or punishment in respect of anything done or omitted before the date of revival.

(4) Every Proclamation under this section shall be laid before the Legislative Assembly within fourteen sitting days after publication in the Gazette if the Legislative Assembly is in session and, if not, then within fourteen sitting days after the commencement of its next session.

(5) If the Legislative Assembly passes a resolution in pursuance of a motion of which notice has been given at any time within fourteen sitting days after a Proclamation under this section has been laid before it disallowing the Proclamation or part thereof, that Proclamation or part shall thereupon cease to have effect but without prejudice to the validity of anything done in the meantime or to the making of a further Proclamation.
