To the Honourable W. E. Knox, M. L. A.,

BRISBANE.

Under its programme of statute law revision as approved by the Honourable the Minister for Justice and Attorney-General, the Law Reform Commission is required to review Imperial Statutes and New South Wales Statutes applicable to the State of Queensland and the Statutes of Queensland with a view to the repeal of those which cannot positively be shown to continue to perform a useful or necessary function and to eliminate any anomalies.

The Commission has decided to concentrate firstly upon the Acts passed in New South Wales which became part of this State's legislation prior to its separation in 1859.

Having regard to the nature of the subject-matter involved it has not been considered necessary to adopt the usual practice of circulating a working paper and instead the Commission has chosen to submit its Report comprising a Commentary and draft Bill direct to the Honourable the Minister.

COMMENTARY

This Act is concerned solely with Queensland legislation which came into existence as Statutes passed by the legislature of New South Wales prior to this State's separation in 1859. Its purpose is not to alter any law but to remove from the Statute Book those enactments which have become obsolete or unnecessary. It also repeals those which have ceased to be in force otherwise than by express and specific repeal. Thus it covers a large number of Acts which are spent or which have been repealed by implication or superseded by later Acts.

As the effect at common law of repealing an Act is that it never existed except for transactions which have been completed, it is necessary to include a 'savings provision' in connection with rights, titles, obligations or liabilities already accrued or acquired under the enactment to be repealed.

The "Westbury Savings" devised by Bethell A. G., later Lord Westbury, had by 1953 reached considerable proportions covering one whole page of the Statute Book and it was argued that they were so comprehensive that they could be held to nullify the effect of the repeal which contained them. The savings clause proposed is in the shorter and modern form.

The categories of enactments which have ceased to be in force otherwise than by express and specific repeal may be classified and defined as follows:-

1. Expired - that is, enactments which, having been originally limited by a distinct provision to endure only for a specified period, have not been either perpetuated or kept in force by continuance or which have had for their object the continuance of previous enactments with limited duration for periods of time now run.
2. Spent - and Operation exhausted - that is, enactments spent or exhausted in operation by the accomplishment of the purposes for which they were passed, either at the moment of their first taking effect, e. g. the repeal of an earlier enactment, or on the happening of some event, e. g. a holiday in honour of a Royal Visit, or on the doing of some act authorised or required, e. g. constructing a bridge or railway.
3. Obsolete - that is, where the state of things contemplated by the enactment has ceased to exist or the enactment is of such a nature as to be no longer capable of being put in force, regard being had to the alteration of social or political circumstances, e. g. hulk in Sydney Harbour.
4. Unnecessary - that is, enactments where the provisions are of such a nature as not to require at the present day statutory authority.

The foregoing categories shade into one another.

5. Repeal in general terms - that is, enactments repealed by the operation of another enactment expressed only in general terms as distinct from an enactment specifying the Acts on which it is to operate.

6. Virtual repeal - this occurs to an enactment where a later enactment is inconsistent with or renders nugatory the provisions of that enactment.
7. Superseded - that is, where the later enactment effects the same purposes as an earlier one by repetition of that earlier enactment's terms or otherwise indicating an intention to cover the same ground without expressly repealing the earlier Act.
8. Inapplicable - that is, enactments wherein the provisions cannot apply to persons or matters within the jurisdiction, e. g. hulk in Sydney Harbour.

It will be seen that inapplicable, obsolete and unnecessary classifications shade into one another.

In the Annexures there is a classification under those titles of all the enactments of New South Wales up to the sixth day of June, 1859 which have been exhausted, superseded or virtually repealed or which never had any application, i. e. were inapplicable to people or circumstances in Queensland after that Colony was separated in 1859. In addition there are listed those enactments which, although passed by the Legislature, were later disallowed or reserved when forwarded for Royal Assent.

The Annexures also set out under the respective headings the classifications (and in some cases comments) shown in the Historical or Chronological Tables of Acts in the Queensland Statutes and Oliver's Statutes of New South Wales, as well as by Government Gazette No. 114 of 7th November, 1872 published pursuant to an Order in Council of the Legislative Assembly dated 25th July, 1872. This lastmentioned source is virtually a reproduction of material contained in Pring's Statutes.

Oliver's work was published in 1881 and contained a chronological table of Public General Acts to that year but did not make any reference to Private or Personal Acts. The Queensland Government Gazette also omits most of these.

Oliver was concerned only with New South Wales laws and their application in that Colony and many of the Acts to which he refers never had application in Queensland after separation. Any comment which he makes must necessarily be read in relation to New South Wales and for that reason is of no assistance to us.

Similarly, many of the enactments which applied to both Colonies continued in force in New South Wales with or without amendment, but were later repealed in Queensland. Such repeals were not noticed by Oliver who in this area also is of limited assistance.

Those Acts specifically repealed since 1859 have not been listed as they are no longer on the Statute Book and are not within the purview of this Bill.

Provision has been made in s. 4 to empower the Governor in Council to revive any enactment which the Bill would repeal. Thus, if later experience indicates that it would be expedient to restore one or other of the enactments repealed, this can be done without the need for further legislation and follows the practice adopted in Victoria in the Imperial Acts Application Act 1922 and the Imperial Acts Application Act 1967 (New South Wales).

Schedule I to the Bill amalgamates in chronological order all the Statutes referred to in the Annexures. The notation against the title of each Statute shows how it has been affected. The authority for such notation can be found by reference to the appropriate Annexure.

A Bill to Repeal certain Acts passed by the Legislature of New South Wales and continued in force in Queensland by Letters Patent dated the sixth day of June, 1859.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Acts Repeal Act 197 .

2. Repeals. The Acts set out in the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed.

3. Savings. The repeal by this Act of any enactment does not -

- (a) revive anything not in force or existing at the commencement of this Act;
- (b) affect the previous operation of any enactment so repealed or anything duly done or suffered under any enactment so repealed;
- (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability accrued, acquired or incurred under any enactment so repealed;
- (d) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any enactment so repealed; or
- (e) affect any investigation, legal proceedings or remedy in respect of such right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed and enforced as if this Act had not been passed

4. Revival of repealed enactments. (1) The Governor in Council may by proclamation published in the Gazette declare that any provision (in this section called "the revived provision") being the whole or any part of any enactment repealed by this Act shall be revived as from the date of publication of the proclamation or a later date to be specified in the proclamation.

(2) On and after the date of revival the revived provision shall, subject to Acts from time to time in force, have such effect as the revived enactment had immediately before the commencement of this Act.

(3) The revival under this section of any revived provision shall not -

- (a) affect the previous operation of any repeal worked by section 2 of this Act;
- (b) affect anything duly done or suffered before the date of revival;
- (c) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability accrued, acquired or incurred before the date of revival, or any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation or liability; or
- (d) make any person liable for any penalty, forfeiture or punishment in respect of anything done or omitted.

(4) Every such proclamation shall be laid before the Legislative Assembly within fourteen sitting days after the date of such proclamation if the Legislative Assembly is then in Session and, if not, then within fourteen sitting days after the commencement of the next Session.

(5) If the Legislative Assembly passes a resolution of which notice has been given at any time within fourteen sitting days after such proclamation has been laid before the Legislative Assembly disallowing such proclamation or part thereof, that proclamation or part shall thereupon cease to have any effect but without prejudice to the validity of anything done in the meantime or to the making of a further proclamation.
